MACADAMIA NUT FARM

Yarramalong Macadamia Nut Farm is recognised as being the southernmost working macadamia nut farm in NSW and easily accessed from Sydney and Newcastle.

The farm is situated on 60 acres of picturesque property, much of which has a rain forest appearance. About 15 acres are devoted to the production of nuts and we have around 900 trees.

We like to give organised groups an informative chat on the type of nuts available and the processes involved in getting them from tree to table. The best thing about our farm is, of course, is the nuts. We sell them in their shell, out of their shell, roasted and our specialty is chocolate coated. You will partake of a leisurely, home baked country style lunch in our cosy tearoom in a picturesque garden environment.

ST BARNABAS CHURCH



Visit this charming historic church, the oldest church building in the Wyong Shire.

It was built by voluntary labour from locally grown and milled timber and consecrated in 1885.

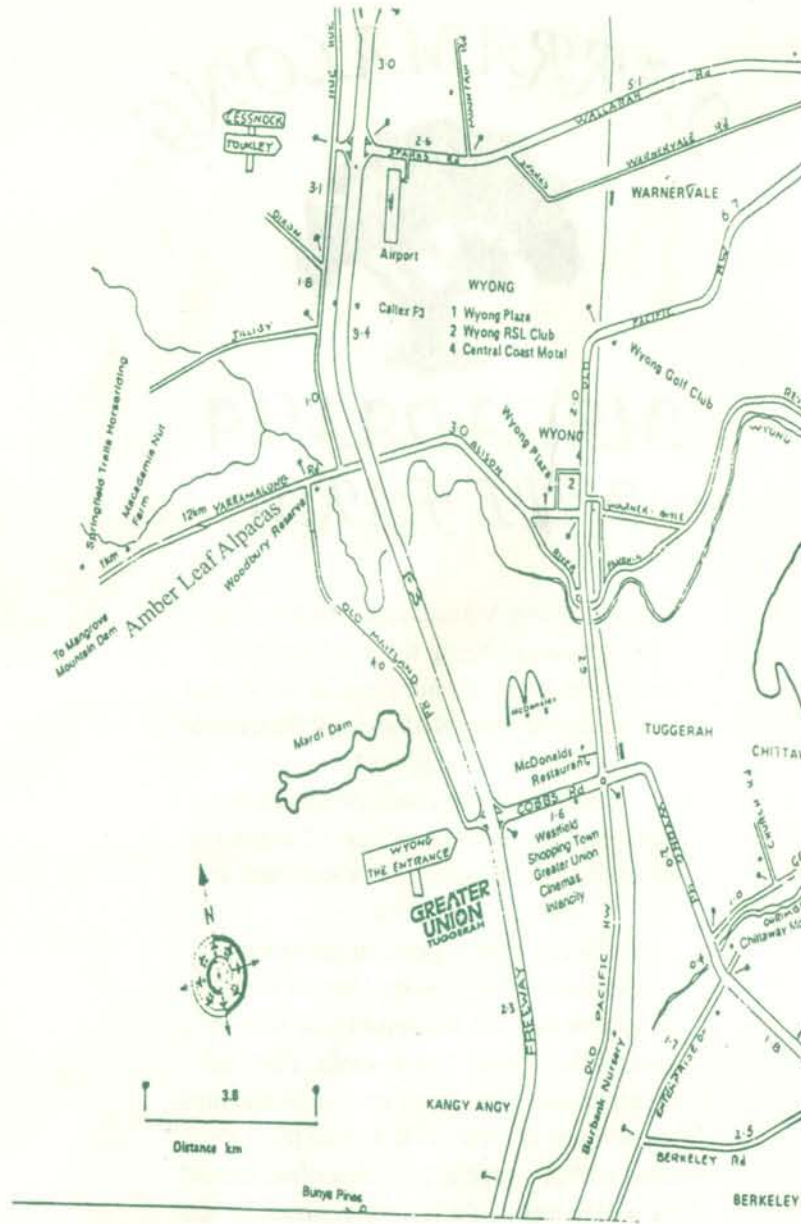
You will be given a brief history of the church and are invited to wander through the church and churchyard if you so wish.

Come by car or hire a bus for your group (minimum 20) and explore this beautiful rural valley of the Central Coast

- Exit the F3 freeway at Tuggerah and turn left into Old Maitland Road until you come to a "T" intersection where you will see Woodbury Reserve (indicated on the map).

- If travelling by car please assemble at Woodbury Reserve to begin your day tour at Amber Leaf Alpacas.
- *Please ensure that you arrive at Amber Leaf Alpacas at the appointed time to begin your Yarramalong Day Tour...if you have been delayed a telephone call would be appreciated to ensure the smooth running of our tours.*

- After you leave Woodbury Reserve proceed along Yarramalong Road for ONLY 500 metres - on the left is Amber Leaf Alpacas. This is the beginning of your day of discovery of the beauty of Yarramalong Valley including lush turf farms, grazing cattle, a riding school and Yarramalong Primary School (est 1887)
